Working with our Pioneer Travellers



The last two months have seen us (Fiona, Sally and Yaw from the SSHS committee and Nic - our Campaign Director) and our academic partners (Dr Mercy Denedo and Professor Amanze Ejiogu) travelling all over the country to work with our 11 wonderful Pioneer Travellers - landlords and tenants who are piloting our Tackling Stigma Journey Planner. The sessions have all led to many ideas for actions to tackle stigma, and over the next three months, we will be working with the Pioneer Travellers to understand how they intend to implement actions.



Interestingly, our identification of tackling stigma as a "journey" appears to be correct. Some of the Pioneer Travellers are already somewhere on their journey. Others are just starting out. But what is important is that all of them have identified actions that will help them to move further down the line.

We are still anticipating that our research report - and a finalised Journey Planner will be produced by ourselves (working with University of Durham and Sheffield Hallam University as well as with partners, the Chartered Institute of Housing, TPAS and YD Consultants) in Spring 2025.

In the meantime, we are planning to hold two SSHS member webinars to discuss some of the key findings from the research (see below).
