Social housing stigma

Inviting scrutiny panels to work with us on stigma scrutiny reviews

SSHS/TPAS joint tackling stigma scrutiny project SSHS and TPAS have joined together to work with tenants and landlords on a joint project to explore how tenants can scrutinise their landlord's approach to tackling stigma.

The **Tackling Stigma Journey Planner** – scrutiny panels may choose to use SSHS's Tackling Stigma Journey Planner to assist in their scrutiny review or may choose to carry out the review in a different way. The Journey Planner is a flexible tool aimed at helping tenants and landlords work together to identify and plan how they will tackle stigma. The Journey Planner is available on SSHS's website.

Key features of the programme

- Up to 8 tenant scrutiny panels will be invited to carry out scrutiny exercises into aspects of stigma in their landlords
- SSHS/TPAS will assist scrutiny panels to develop their scrutiny programmes
- SSHS/TPAS will provide assistance during the review as requested
- It is anticipated that each review will last about 6 months
- SSHS/TPAS will meet with each scrutiny panel at the end of the programme to discuss findings
- SSHS/TPAS will consider each scrutiny review and draw out any common themes
- SSHS/TPAS will produce a final report for the programme and launch it.
- SSHS/TPAS will explore how the scrutiny panels can come together to discuss their programmes.

- Some good national publicity of a tenant-led approach
